

**Iredell–Statesville Association of Educators/North Carolina Association of Educators
Future Teacher’s Scholarship
For Graduating Seniors and Teacher’s Assistants Pursuing a Career in Education**

I. Application Requirements/Considerations

- A. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or a teacher’s assistant in the Iredell-Statesville school district whose proposed profession will be a career in teaching and who has been accepted to a North Carolina institute of higher learning.
- B. Financial Need
- C. Academic Excellence (high school seniors), Above Standard Performance (teacher’s assistants)
- D. Community Involvement
- E. Preference will be given to high school seniors whose parents are members of NCAE. Teacher’s assistants applying must be current members of NCAE.
- F. Submit each of the following by **April 30, 2009**:
 - i. Completed personal data form (attached)
 - ii. Most current official transcript (high school seniors), most current evaluation (teacher’s assistants)
 - iii. Two letters of recommendation (For high school seniors, one must be from a current teacher; for teacher’s assistants, one must be from current supervising teacher)
 - iv. One page essay responding to the following prompt: Consider your own meaning of school. Provide a definition of school as related to your personal experiences and your vision as an educator.

II. Payment of Scholarship

- A. Scholarship payment for graduating high school senior is \$1000 and \$500 for teacher’s assistant. Recipient must be enrolled in a two or four year North Carolina institution of higher learning at time of payment. Payment will be made in the name of the recipient to the college/university of his or her choice.
- B. Recipients will be awarded scholarships at the Retirees’ Reception in May and/or at his or her school’s Awards Ceremony.

III. Submission of Applications

- A. All complete applications need to be sent via courier or post to Kaye Taliana at Lake Norman High School by April 30, 2009.
